

# Color Wheel Worksheets

---

*Useful templates for exploring color in arts and crafts like painting, quilting, knitting and other fiber arts.*

Page 1-- 12 step color wheel with interior circle  
Use to print on 8.5 x 11  
Trace on 9 x 12; 11 x 14; 14 x 17

Page 2 -- 12 step color wheel, no interior circle  
Trace on 11 x 14; 14 x 17  
(Image is almost edge to edge on 8.5 x 11)

Page 3 – 12 step color wheel with interior circle  
Sized fits 5.5 x 8.5 sketchbook

## PRINTING NOTES:

All images are designed to be printed on 8.5 x 11 paper.

Use 9 x 12 tracing paper by cutting ½ inch off the long side of the paper. A rotary cutter, see through plexiglass ruler and cutting mat are useful for this cut. The result is a sheet of paper 8.5 x 12 which will go thru the printer successfully.

Insert tracing paper or heavy stock paper into inkjet printer one sheet at a time.

Experimenting with an inkjet printer may result in being able to print on paper other than regular weight. I have successfully printed on paper up to 60lb using both HP and Epson inkjet printers. Sometimes I hold the single sheet and give a slight nudge to the sheet as the printer take up mechanism engages the printer.

In many inkjet printers the paper is loaded upside down. The paper probably has to take a U turn, so that heavy papers, if they are flexible enough, might work.

*Enjoy using these templates. I developed them to use for watercolor exploration but you will find many uses for them in your art work.*
